Whatcom W. T. Sep. 12th 1883

A meeting of the members and friends of the Episcopal Church in the town of Whatcom was held at the house of Mrs. Gardner on Wednesday the 12th of Sep. at 3 P.M. pursuant to a call made by Rev. F D Nevius D.D. to secure organized action in prosecuting church works.

The object of the Guild shall be furtherance of Christian work in the corporate Town of Whatcom.
